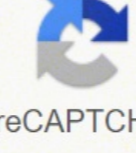


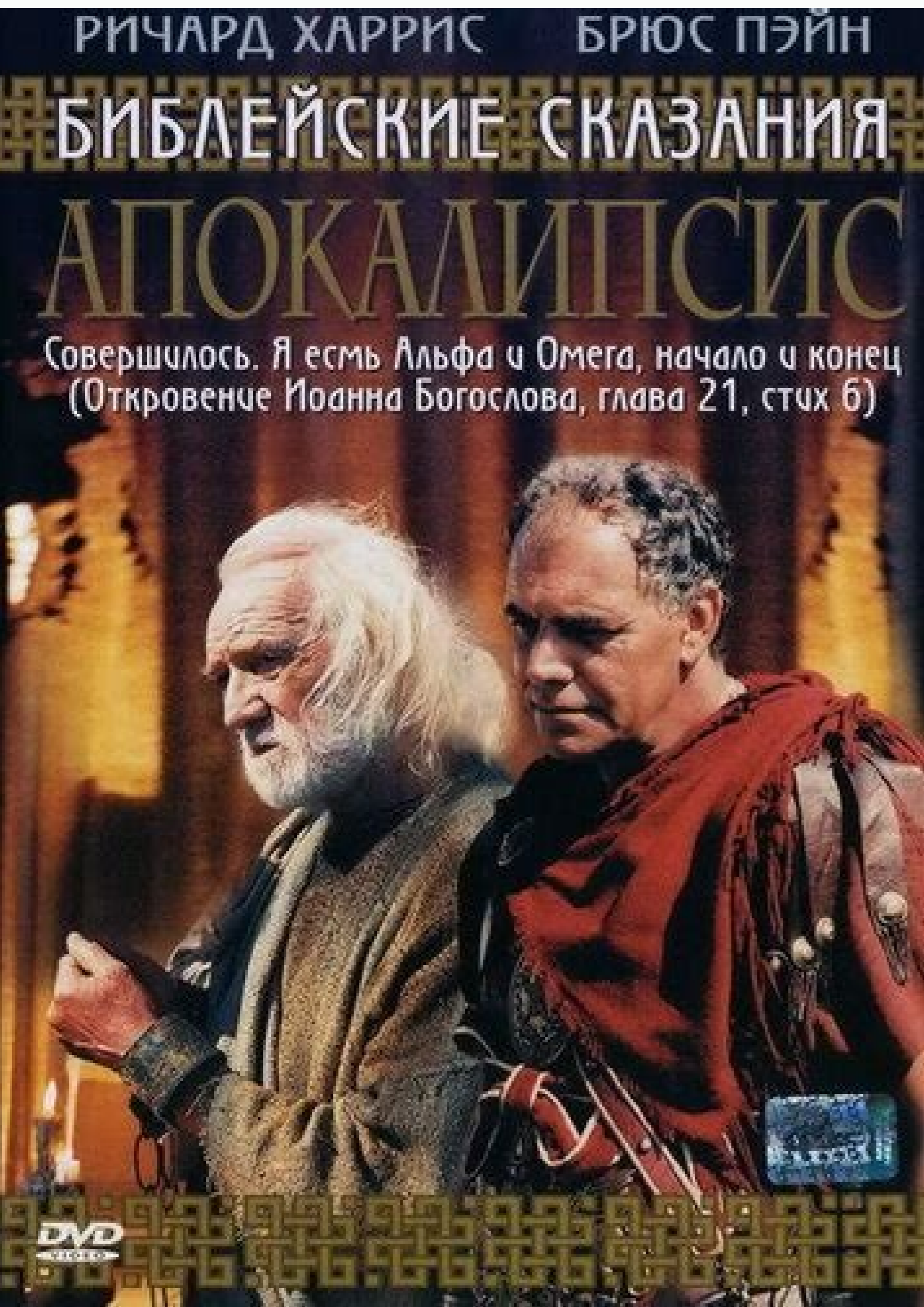
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God in the Queen's "Caliban upon Setebos"

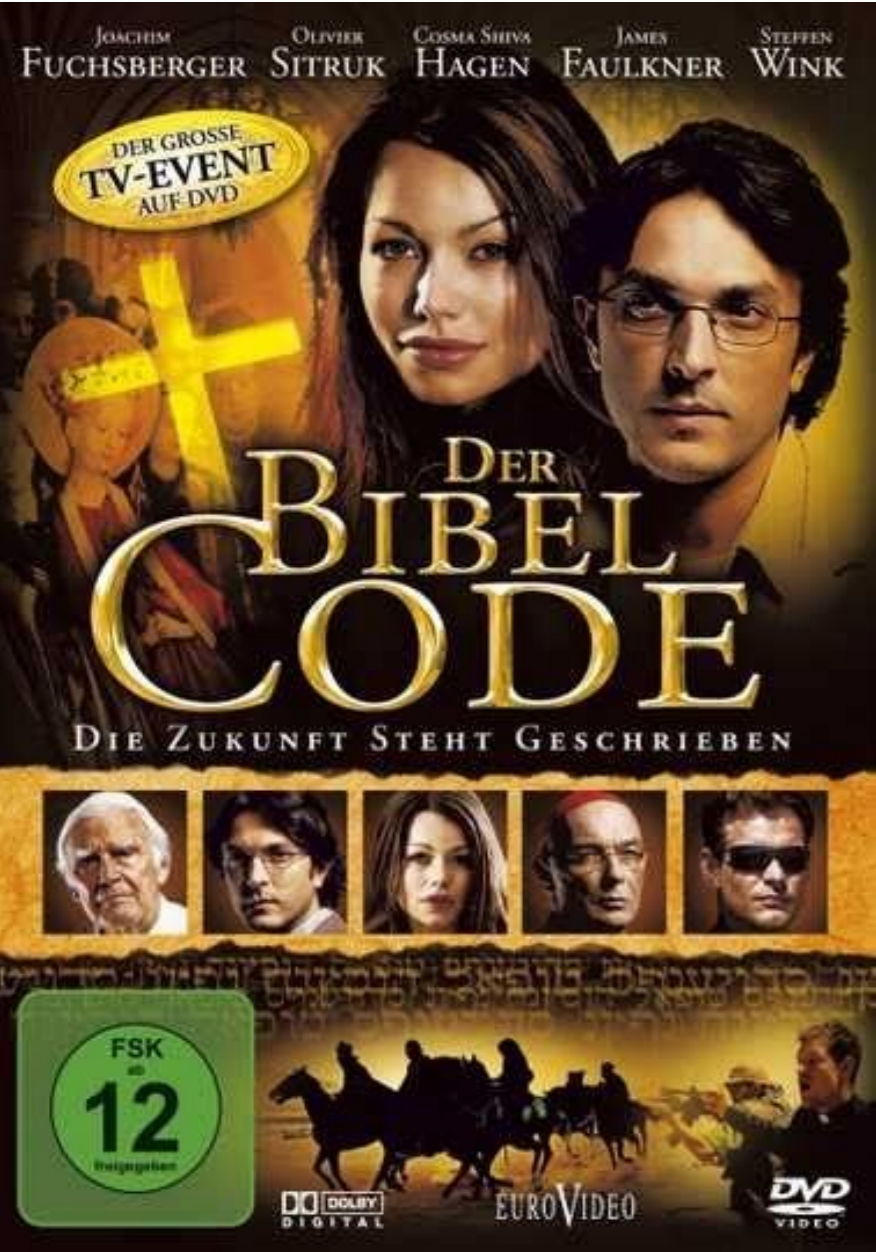


### Specifying Additional Codes
